No proposals will be accepted after the above-mentioned date and time. Proposals must be submitted in sealed envelopes with the name of the RFP clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. If hand-delivering proposal must be left in the marked bin accessible from the 6th Street entrance to the Courthouse. Bin access is M-F 8:30 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. Proposals may not be faxed or transmitted over the telephone. See additional submission requirements in RFP document on page 2.
